November Garden Tips

- Annual beds should all be cleaned out by now.
- Early in November you still have time to prepare your beds for winter. See ([Preparing Your Perennial Garden for Winter](#))
- Trunk wrap softwood trees, newly planted, and in high deer traffic to protect from frost cracking and deer damage. See ([Tree Wrapping](#))
- Continue to water your trees until ground freezes.
- Finalize your leaf cleanups and cut the lawn down a little shorter the last time.
- Winterize your equipment, clean the mower decks and sharpen blades. Add a fuel stabilizer to the tank and run the engine to get it all the way through the system.
- Have Snow blower serviced and ready to go with new spark plug.
